

Subject: Information on Open Calls for the Fulbright Programs for the 2022-2023 Academic Year

Dear prospective applicant,

On behalf of the U.S. Embassy in Kosovo, we wanted to share the exciting news regarding the open calls of the Fulbright Program for the 2022-2023 academic year!

The Fulbright Faculty Development Program model is designed for junior faculty, currently teaching in Kosovo. Applicants should intend to return to their position at their home institution upon completion of the program, continue their teaching responsibilities, and apply newly gained knowledge and experience. The Fulbright Faculty Development program is structured as a 5-month grant, beginning in the middle of August, and ending in the middle of January. The goal of the program model is to introduce participants to best practices and theoretical approaches to curriculum development in the U.S. and provide them with concrete strategies on how to develop curriculum for a course, including an overview of academic and research resources. During the program, fellows will be expected to research and develop a course description, syllabus and outline specific teaching strategies for their proposed course.

The Fulbright Visiting Scholar Program is a non-degree post-doctoral award program for junior and senior researchers, university lecturers, and experts from academic and research institutions in Kosovo. This program brings scholars to the United States for advanced research for a period of three to six months. The program provides tuition, monthly maintenance allowance, a book and supplies allowance, and round-trip international travel to the host institution.

The Fulbright-National Archives Heritage Science Fellowship, a component of the Fulbright Visiting Scholar Program, provides an opportunity for Fulbright visiting scholars to connect with National Archives scientists and experts while conducting research at the National Archives' state-of-the-art Heritage Science Research and Testing Lab in College Park, Maryland. This Fellowship is made possible through a partnership between the U.S. Department of State and the National Archives and Records Administration. The award was established to support archival science education, conservation, and research.

The selected Fellow will work in the Heritage Science Research and Testing Laboratory of the National Archives, a state-of-the-art facility focused on scientific research to assist in the conservation, preservation, and ongoing public accessibility of cultural and historic artifacts, records, and documents.
